Yard and food waste program continues at Vashon Recycling and Transfer Station

Vashon residents and businesses:

- Bring your yard and food waste (separated from garbage and recyclable materials) to Vashon Recycling and Transfer Station. See other side for details.
- Fees for yard and food waste are **lower** than garbage fees.
- Minimum fee: \$12 per entry. Covers up to 320 lbs.
- Per ton fee: \$75

King County sends the yard and food waste to privately owned Cedar Grove Composting, Inc. to be composted.

Important recycling information


- An estimated 70% of what is landfilled in King County could have been reused, recycled, or composted.

Yard waste

- Branches, brush
- Holiday trees
- Grass clippings
- Leaves, weeds

The following materials are NOT accepted with yard

waste: Rocks, sod, soil, glass, metal, plastic, plastic bags, or pet waste. Yard waste must be no longer than 8 feet. No branches can be more than 4 inches in diameter.

Food waste

- Breads, pastas
- Bones, fish, meat, poultry
- Coffee grounds, paper coffee filters
- Dairy products (cheeses, yogurt)
- Egg shells, nutshells
- Fruit and vegetable scraps
- Tea bags, tea leaves



The following materials are NOT accepted with food waste:

Glass, metal, plastic, compostable utensils or food-soiled paper products such as paper napkins, paper towels, paper plates, pizza boxes and take-out containers.

Food waste can be collected in a small kitchen countertop container with a compostable bag liner approved by Cedar Grove Composting. Visit *cedar-grove.com/* compostable/accepted-items/bags to see brands of compostable bag liners approved by Cedar Grove Composting. Approved bag liners are sold at these Vashon retailers: Island Home Center & Lumber, Thriftway, and IGA.
